About this Document

This document describes the operation of the SUPERSET™ 4025 TSG telephone. It also provides information about using the telephone with peripheral devices.

What is a SUPERSET 4025 TSG Telephone?

A SUPERSET 4025 TSG telephone is a standard Mitel Networks™ SUPERSET 4025 telephone that meets the Telephone Security Group (TSG) requirements for a Class 2 secure electronic telephone.

Starting the SUPERSET 4025 TSG Telephone

To start the SUPERSET 4025 TSG telephone

- 1 Press and hold the two Start-up buttons simultaneously.
- 2 When the backlight of the display turns on, release the buttons.

SUPERSET 4025 TSG Telephone Operation

The SUPERSET 4025 TSG telephones are standard Mitel Networks telephones except for the following:

Handsfree Operation

Handsfree operation is not supported. This means that the Speaker and Microphone buttons do not function.

Headset Operation

Headset operation is not supported.

Background Music

The background music feature is not supported.

On-hook Dialing

On-hook dialing is supported; however, you must pick up the handset to speak to the called party.

New Call Tone

A tone will not alert you that a new call is waiting when you are busy on a call.

Call Announce

The Call Announce feature is not supported.

Auto-Answer

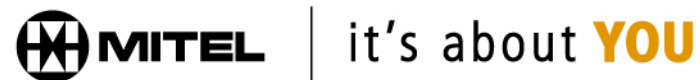
The Auto-Answer feature is not supported.

The SUPERSET 4025 TSG telephone supports the SUPERSET Installation Module (SIM) 1 which provides connectivity between the telephone and a SUPERSET PKM48 Programmable Key Module. SIM 2, which provides additional connectivity with devices such as modems and fax machines, is not supported.
