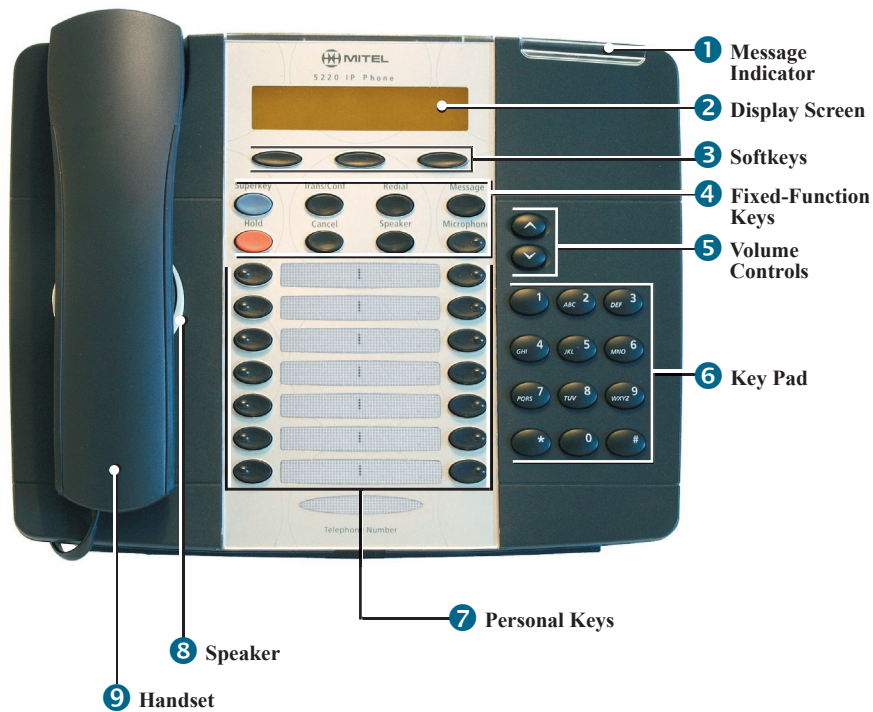

Making a Call

- 9 Lift the handset.
- 6 Dial the number,
- 7 or Press a Speed Call,
- 4 or Press **Redial**.

Placing a Call on Hold

- 4 Press **Hold**.

Retrieving a Call from Hold

- 7 Press the flashing line key.

Leaving a Message

- 1 If the message indicator is lit,
- 4 Press **Message**, or if a voice mail system answers, record a message.

Retrieving a Message

- 4 Press **Message**.
- 3 If "Call Me Back" appears, press **Yes**.
- 3 Press **Call** to call the message sender, or Press **Erase** to erase the message.

Transferring a Call

- 4 Press **Trans/Conf**.
- 6 Dial the number.
- 9 Hang up, or Announce the transfer and hang up.

Conferencing Calls

- 4 Press **Trans/Conf**.
- 6 Dial the number. Wait for an answer.
- 4 Press **Trans/Conf**.

Programming a Speed Call

- 4 Press **Superkey**.
- 3 Press **No** until "Personal Keys?" appears.
- 3 Press **Yes**.
- 7 Press a personal key.
- 3 Press **Change**.
- 3 Press **Yes**.
- 6 Dial the number,
- 4 or Press **Redial**.
- 3 Press **Save**.
- 4 Press **Superkey**.
